Eighth Grade Summer Reading

Students will need to read **TWO** books over the Summer break.

Students are to select their books from the list below and it must not be a book that they have previously read. For each book, a report is to be written and submitted on the first day of school.

Your report must be approximately **two typed pages**. The **font size must be no larger than 12** (Font style- *Times New Roman*). Please use double spacing and have **one inch margins** on all sides. Your name, grade and date should be on the top left of your report.

Book Report Outline -

- Title and Author
- A good place to start your report is to explain what you believe the author's purpose and/or the main theme of the book is.
- Then provide brief descriptions of the setting, the point of view (who tells the story), and other main characters. If there is a distinct mood or tone in the writing, discuss that as well.
- Write a summary. But don't try to summarize each chapter. Choose the most significant points/events in the story. Begin with the sequence of major events, the book's climax and conclusion (how did things turn out).
- Give your opinion – Consider these questions: Did you think the writing was inspirational, poetic, or difficult? Did you enjoy reading the book and would you recommend it to someone else? If so, why or why not?
- Briefly conclude by pulling your thoughts together. You may want to say what impression the book left you with, or emphasize what you want the reader of your report to know about the book.
