

Summer Reading for Grade Two

This summer your child should read two books and complete an activity for each book. The first book should be one of the Henry and Mudge books by Cynthia Rylant. These Henry and Mudge books are funny stories about Henry's adventures with his big dog Mudge. Your child may read the book independently or with your assistance.

The second book should be a book of your child's choice that is 35 pages or more. Now don't let this scare you; this is including pictures and large print. This can be any book that is of interest to your child. (Suggestions from the following series: Junie B. Jones, Cam Jansen, Amber Brown, any level 2 or 3 readers, and even another Henry and Mudge book if desired.) Your child may read this book independently or with your assistance as well.

Book Reports: I have attached two worksheets. Your child should complete one worksheet for each book they have read. Please answer each question completely, even if you have to write more sentences than I have asked for. The picture in the back should tell part of the story. Please make sure that your child's picture is colorful because we will be sharing these with our classmates on the first day of school.

All work should be done neatly with your child's best effort put forth. I'm looking forward to displaying these when the children return to school.

***This assignment is due the first day of school. This will be the first reading grade for the first quarter and will count as a large part of their grade.
