

Summer Reading Assignment for Sixth Grade

Your reading assignment for the summer is to read Robin Hood, by Roger Lancelyn Green. After reading this book, choose **ONE** option below as your summer reading project. This will be due on the Thursday after school begins.

1. Construct puppets and present a show of one or more interesting parts of the book (Approximately 5-10 min).
2. Construct a diorama (three-dimensional scene which includes models of people, buildings, plants, and animals) of one of the main events of the book. Include a written description of the scene, which should be at least 2-3 paragraphs. A shoebox is the ideal size for a diorama.
3. Write and perform an original song that tells the story of the book (At least 5 minutes).
4. Create a newspaper for your book. Summarize the plot in one article, cover the weather in another, do a feature story on one of the more interesting characters in another. Include an editorial and a collection of ads that would be pertinent to the story.
